

Report on the 7th Neurological Disorders Summit (NDS-2022)

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Meeting Report

The 7th Neurological Disorders Summit (NDS-2022) organized by United Scientific Group was held from July 18, 2022 to July 21, 2022 in Hybrid mode (In-person & Virtual). 114 attendees from more than 25 countries presented at NDS-2022 over 4 days with 5 keynote lectures, 60 oral and 30 poster and 2 exhibitor presentations. Of the keynote speakers, opening talk given by Dr. Giulio M Pasinetti, Icahn School of Medicine at Mount Sinai, USA on “Role of Gut Microbiota-derived Metabolites in Neurodegenerative Disorders Involving Protein Misfolding and C9orf72 Expansion”. Dr. Kalpna Gupta, University of California-Irvine, USA presented “Brain, Pain and Environment”. Dr. Jin Jun Luo (Editor-in-Chief: JNEN (Journal of Neurology and Experimental Neuroscience)) from Temple University, USA Lectured “Do We Stand on Solid in Administering Aducanumab to Patients with Alzheimer’s Disease?”. Dr. Rajendra Badgaiyan from University of Texas Health, USA addressed “Real-time Measurement of Dopamine Released in the Live Human Brain” and last keynote talk given by Dr. Kenneth Blum (Co-Chairman of NDS-2022), Western University College of Medicine, USA on “Genetic Addiction Risk Severity Test Applications for Reward Deficiency Syndrome: The Future is Now”.

Oral and poster presentations were carried out on various topics including “Alzheimer’s Disease, Dementia and Mild Cognitive Impairment”, “Stroke & Neurotrauma”, “Autism and Neurodevelopmental Disorders”, “Neurological Disorders: Diagnostics, Treatments and Rehabilitation”, “Stroke, Migraine & Headache”. Those presentations demonstrated the first hand findings of basic and/or clinical researches which were well appreciated by the participants.
